# IS GOD GOING TO LET US DESTROY OURSELVES?

No. Although we rejected God's first offer of life, he has extended the same offer again—this time, through his son Jesus.

If you want to know what God is really like, look at Jesus. In Jesus, we see God up close and personal—loving us, caring for us, forgiving us, and showing us the way back to the life he promised in the beginning.

Jesus died on the cross so our sins could be forgiven. But the Good News is, he rose from the dead to give us a new life with God, both now and forever.

## HOW'S IT ALL GOING TO END?

First, you must admit to God that you're the reason your life is flawed and you can't do anything to earn or deserve his forgiveness. Second, you must trust that what Jesus did for you is all you need to start a brand new life with God.

By sending Jesus to be punished in your place, God has shown how far he's willing to go to rescue you. Remember, he will not force you to believe, but the choice you make will stand forever.

So if your heart is awakened by the desire to re-enter this sacred romance that God intended from the start, tell him now. Tell God you know you're flawed, and that you need his forgiveness to really live. Tell him you are trusting in Jesus—his death and resurrection—to forgive your sin and to give you a brand new life with God.

If you want to tell God now, pray this simple prayer:

Jesus, now I understand how much you love me. I know I've turned my back on you, but I thank you for opening my eyes to the truth. I am a sinner that needs your forgiveness. Thank you for living the life I could never live, for dying in my place, and for rising again to make my new life possible. I take you at your word to forgive me, and right now, I'm turning from my sin and trusting you for forgiveness and a new life.

"Jesus said, I tell you the truth, anyone who trusts in me has eternal life." **John 6:47**
