

## FG Students On-Campus Plan

We are so excited to welcome back FG students to onsite programming this fall. Our goal is to make your student's experience as comfortable and engaging as possible, while also keeping them safe and healthy! We recognize that everyone feels different right now, and we want you to know that we respect whatever you choose to do.

### Three Options:

- Continue to stream the Middle School worship service (live on our YouTube page at 9:00 am) and the main service from home. Note: The 9:00 am service is the only FGS service that we will be streaming.
- Come to church as a family and sit together in the service in Auditorium 1 or 2.
- Have your student join us for Middle School services (at 9:00 or 11:00 am) or High School service (6-8:00 pm) on Sundays.
  - Respectful distancing is encouraged, and a separate section for masks only is available.

### Steps we are taking to provide a safe environment:

- Rooms / public spaces will be cleaned and sanitized before and after each service.
- Frequent hand washing and sanitizing (for volunteers and students)
- Small group rooms will have limited capacity to allow for respectful distancing.
- Respectful distancing will be encouraged during middle and high school services, and a separate section for enforced social distancing and masks will be available in each service.
- For Middle School services, seats will be set up with space between each seat to encourage respectful distancing.
- For High School services, students will meet in Auditorium 2 with plenty of space to spread out.
- We will only be selling/giving out packaged food (ie. wrapped candy, soda cans).
- We will do our best to encourage respectful distancing and allow space to spread out.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for students to use before and after checking in at the computers. Volunteers will be available to check-in students who are not comfortable touching the screens.

### Steps we are asking you to take:

- Please remain home if your student or anyone in your household has been exposed to COVID-19, or if your student or anyone in your household has any of the following

symptoms: fever, shortness of breath, cough, runny nose, sore throat, loss of sense of taste or smell, upset stomach.

- Face masks are optional for students.
- If you are comfortable, consider setting a meeting place with your student(s) somewhere in the church to limit the number of people in the student building during pick up (for example: the door where you usually enter, the commons area, or the courtyard)
- Please pick up your student or encourage them to head to your meeting place as soon as the service ends so that we can clean after each use and allow our volunteers to go to the main service or leave for lunch and family time
